To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 7057 for 40 acres, issued in favor of *Spencer Lewis corporal in Captain Campbell's Company first Regiment Alabama Volunteers Florida War*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *North West fractional quarter of the South East fractional quarter of Section Nine, in Township Six North, of Range Five East, in the district of Lands subject to sale Helena Arkansas containing Forty one acres, and forty hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *Excess paid for as per Receiver's Receipt No. 8709*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Spencer Lewis*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Spencer Lewis and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
